### 6. Description of agenda item:

Amelia Perez Silverman and Jeffrey Silverman have pledged a seven-figure gift to Cal State LA to name The Ronald H. Silverman Fine Arts Gallery. Ron was an alumnus of Cal State LA, as well as emeritus faculty of the Department of Art. His son, Jeff, and his daughter-in-law, Amelia, are also alumni of the University. The entire Silverman family has been financially supportive of and deeply involved with Cal State LA for many years.

### 7. Justification:

Through this seven-figure gift, the Silverman family has requested the rights to rename the Fine Arts Gallery for the late Ronald Silverman. This gift will provide for maintenance and upkeep of the gallery, through an endowment, and is in accordance with University Advancement naming guidelines. This naming will exist in perpetuity, and will follow the space should the gallery be relocated at some point in the future.

The Fine Arts Gallery offers year-round exhibitions by students, faculty, alumni and other external artists. It is a significant part of the art department's curriculum, and it also offers opportunities for engagement – of the local community, the arts community, and the University's many constituencies. The endowment will allow for enhancements to and potentially increased use of the space.

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

# NAGUISA

Product Data Sheet



Naguisa turns spaces into harmonious landscapes. Its curved, hollowed-out surfaces create meandering, organic resting points. Naguisa is at home in large-scale parks and plazas as well as narrow pedestrian streets and small-scale natural areas. The 63-centimeter high central zone of the reinforced cast stone bench serves as a backrest/armrest, while the 38 centimeter-high zone gently beckons sitters.

By joining several of the four-meter curved arcs together, closed circles with 7.5 or 11 meter diameters can be formed. The pieces can also be arranged in parallel lines, creating a sinuous bench application. In 2007, Naguisa was awarded the Silver Delta Prize by the Association of Industrial Designers for the Encouragement of the Decorative Arts (ADI-FAD).

### Bench

- Naguisa is a series of modular arc-shaped benches.
- · Available in four different sizes.
- Backed benches can be arranged to create closed circles or zigzag arrangements.
- · Closed circles have a 7.5 or 11 meter diameter.
- · Benches are freestanding.
- Naguisa is constructed of reinforced cast stone (see below for further detail).

### Material

- Reinforced Cast Stone is cast stone that is poured and cast over a stainless steel bar cage built to fit within the walls of the mold.
- Reinforced Cast Stone makes it possible to cast thinner, irregularly shaped forms while retaining appropriate strength.
- The colors of Escofet cast stone products are neutral, muted and earth-toned and are derived from the aggregates used in casting.
- No color is added in manufacture and no color is applied to finished products.
- The color range of every Escofet cast stone product is predetermined by the formulation used in its manufacture.
- Cast stone products do not require any specific maintenance during their estimated lifespan of more than 30 years. Water absorption and freeze-thaw cycles can cause weathering, a reproduction of the process that takes place in natural rock.
- Escofet applies a waterproof finish to its products to protect against this process.
- · Escofet cast stone products are large and heavy.
- Shipping, receiving, staging and installing these pieces is more akin to handling large statuary or pre-fabricated architectural elements.




