### \*Upper Division General Education Requirements:

Students are required to complete 9 units of upper division general education courses distributed across three subject areas: Humanities, Natural Sciences, and Social Sciences.

Additionally, the following requirements must be met with the upper division general education courses selected:

- Civic Learning/Community Engagelemt Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) course, with at least one in their major.

*Please note: Only the 8 Required Prerequisite Courses listed above must be completed before transferring to Cal State LA as an admitted Traditional BSN student. Full CSU GE Breadth Certification and the 3 Required Major Courses in fields related to nursing can be completed at the community college level before transferring to Cal State LA, but they are not required to be completed prior to transfer.*
