***Effective Fall 2021, students are required to take the GE Area F: Ethnic Studies course as part of the General Education Program. Meet with your academic advisor for more information.

Parentheses () indicate General Education areas and requirements

- Civic Learning/Community Engagement Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) courses, with at least one in their major.
