All Pre-Nursing students must apply to Nursing program in the first Spring semester. Those not admitted must choose a different major.

*Courses are required prerequisites/corequisites for BSN program (math category 3 students must complete MATH 1090 with a lab. CHEM 1010 and BIOL 2030 are restricted courses for this category. Contact your advisor for more information)

**MICRO 2010 is a 3-unit lecture course and MICRO 2020 is the 1-unit lab component for a total of 4 units

****Courses are required within the Nursing major (NOTE: NTRS 2500 will also meet the Nutrition requirement. If NTRS 3510 is not taken to meet the Nutrition requirement, choose another UD GE Area 2 or 5 course)

*****IHE is required for graduation (strongly recommended to be taken first semester, second semester sections are limited)

Parentheses () indicate General Education areas and requirements

- Civic Learning/Community Engagemt Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) course, with at least one in their major.
