# Expiration of CITI Training

After your training has expired (3 years for IACUC, 3 years for IRB) you will receive an email from CITI program stating that you need to renew your training. You will receive an email notice from CITI 180 days, then 90 days, then 30 days prior to the expiration date for your course. To renew your training, simply log back in using the same CITI Program username and password you had created initially.
