

DEED OF AGREEMENT WITH RESTRICTIONS (NARRATOR)

Kennedy Library and Asian/Asian American Studies Program, where they are available for use according to the University's mission, including but not limited to exhibitions, public programs, film, radio broadcasts, and publications (in all forms) including the Internet.

I further understand that I will have the opportunity to review and approve my interview before it is placed in the repository and made available to the public. Once I have approved it, the oral history project/repository will make my interview available for research without restriction. Future uses may include quotation in printed materials, exhibits and displays or audio/video excerpts in any media and availability on the Internet.
