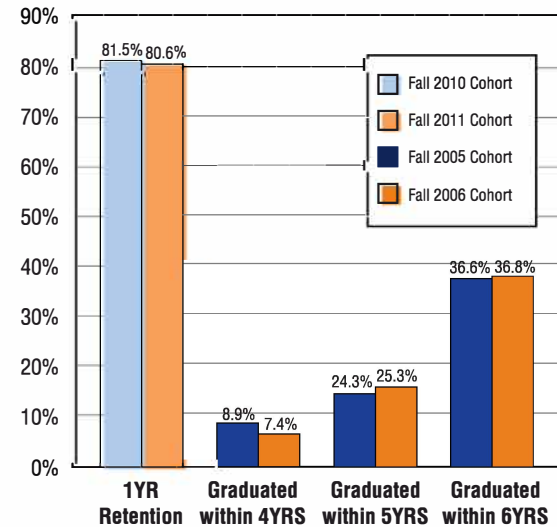

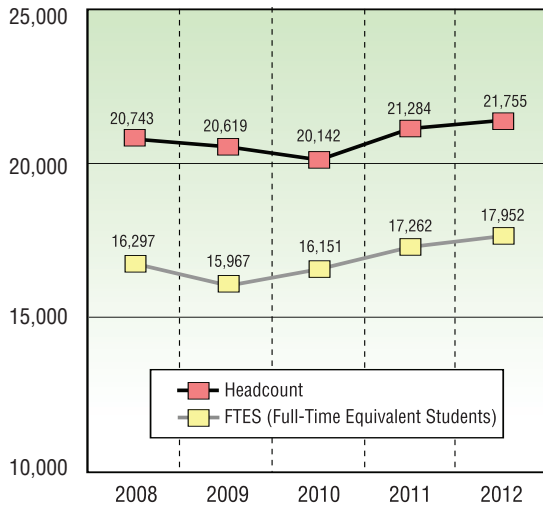

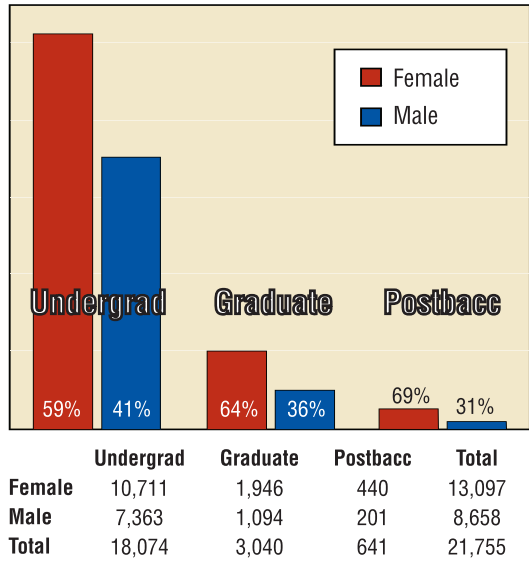
• The average study load is 12.6 units for undergraduates, 9.2 for graduates/postbaccalaureates, and 12.1 overall.

Average Age

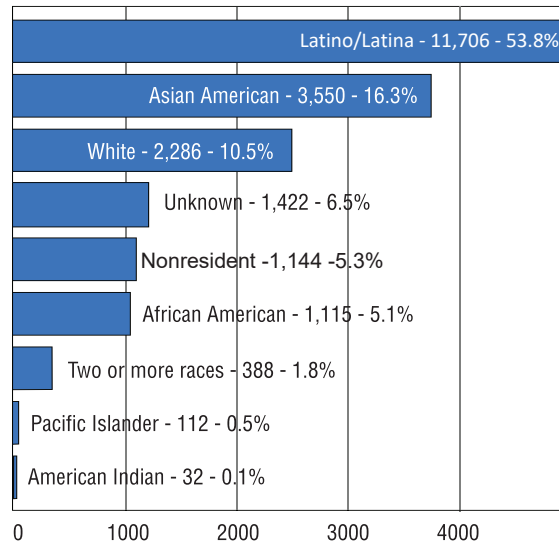
The average age* of undergraduates is 23.5, while that of graduates and post baccalaureates is 32.3. The average for the combined group is 25.0.

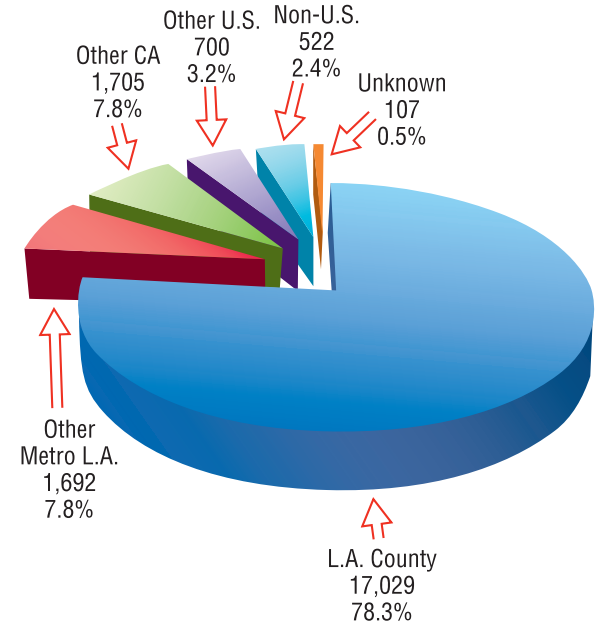
Headcount by Gender
