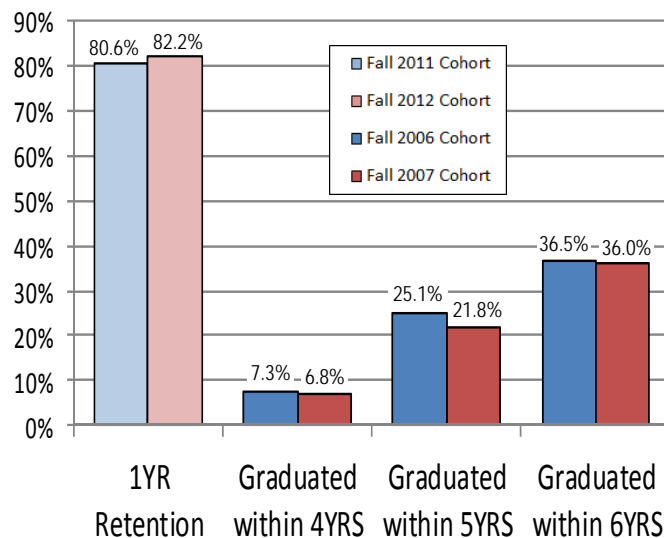

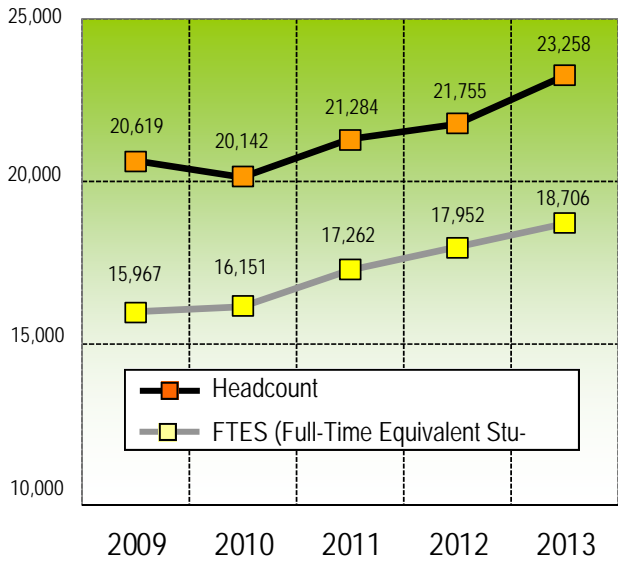

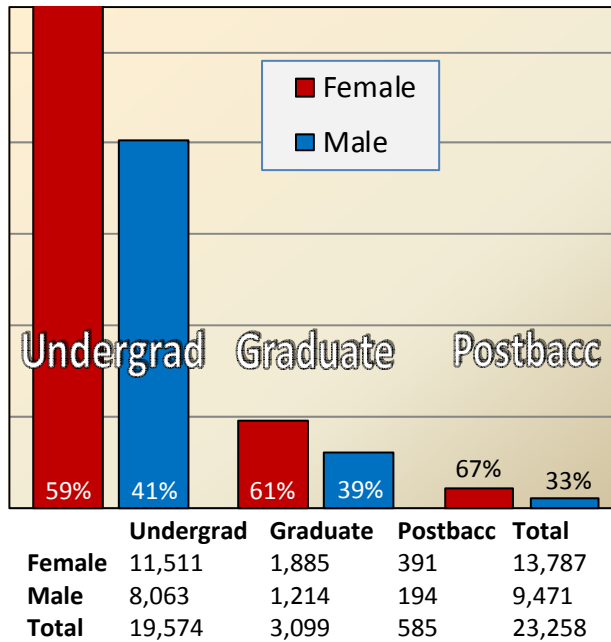

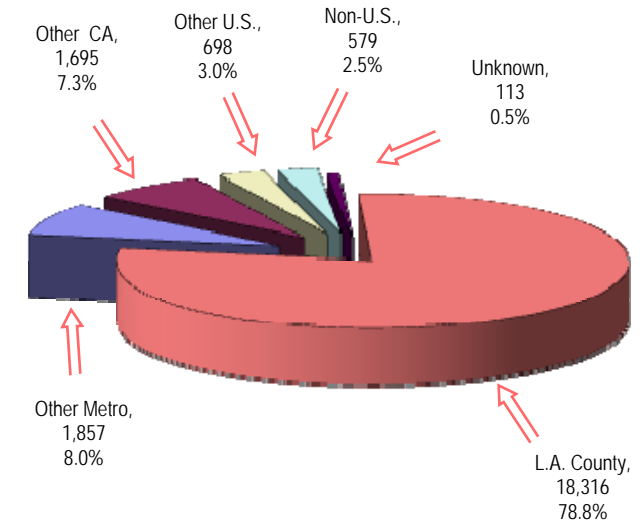
### Headcount + FTES: Fall 2009-2013

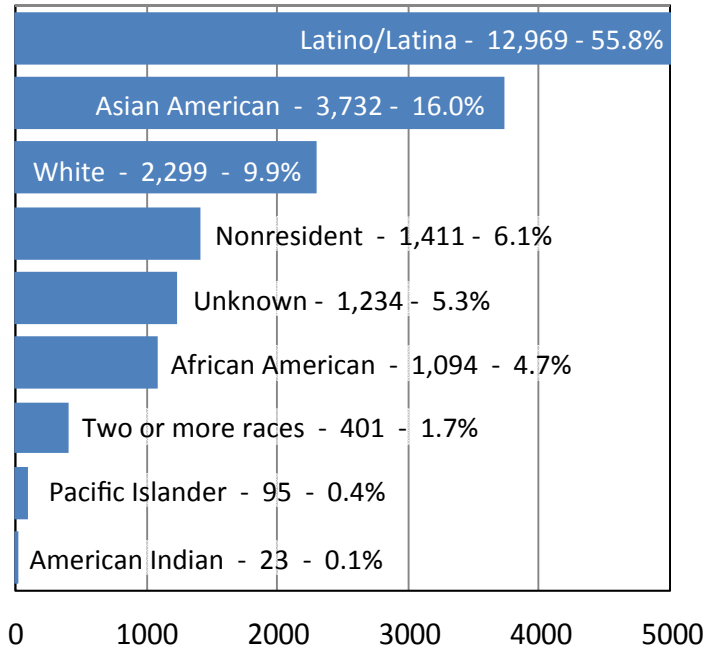
