Instructions: *Please take the required courses first.* All coursework must be completed with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Note that students who file for graduation and complete all major and GE requirements will be graduated from the university *even if they have not completed the minor*. Under these circumstances, there will be no opportunity to complete the coursework necessary for the minor. Therefore, it is required that students complete their minor either **before** or **simultaneous with** the completion of the graduation requirements for their major.
