Students are strongly encouraged, with advisor approval, to use their electives to formulate a concentration in an area such as literary analysis; composition, rhetoric, and language, or creative writing.</p>	<p><b>6-12 units</b> Select from 4000- or 5000-level ENGL courses with adviser approval. 3 units may be in a related field. A maximum of 4 units of ENGL 5980 can be applied to the degree. No more than 3 units at the 4000-level can be applied to the degree. Students are strongly encouraged, with advisor approval, to use their electives to formulate a concentration in an area such as literary analysis; composition, rhetoric, and language, or creative writing.</p>
