Why Minor in Real Estate?

You take most of the real estate courses of a major without having to take the other 17-18 business core courses. *So you are marketable for many of the real estate positions that majors are.*

Our program meets the requirements to sit for the California Real Estate Salesperson Exam and the Degree Requirement for the Brokers Exam.

Most real estate careers to require only competence with arithmetic. Even FIN 3030 (Business Finance) and FIN 4390 (Real Estate Finance), only require that you be good at addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. And most of your calculations will be done using a financial calculator or excel.

Are there any other prerequisites?

You will need Acct 2100 (Introductory Financial Accounting) to take Fin 3030, and Fin 2050 (Business Law), or the equivalent at a JC, to take Fin 3810. However, you can structure your degree to get around those prerequisites.
