In 1928, Stalin discarded the New Economic Policy and implemented his first five-year plan with the slogan "Socialism in One Country." In this artwork by Gustav Klutsis, Stalin is portrayed as a towering figure who gloriously build the industrialization of the Soviet Union. Despite his contribution to Soviet Propaganda and Stalin's imagery, Klutsis was arrested and executed by the NKVD in 1938 by order of Stalin.
